SCREENING: NGRT and Vernon spelling (start of each year)

Identify the students with reading and/or spelling standardised score/s of 84 and below.

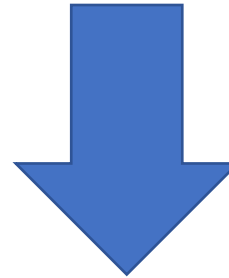
*The information from these tests **cannot** be used as evidence on the Form 8.*

TEACHER FEEDBACK

Teachers asked to complete 'access arrangements evidence report' for any student who requires additional support.

Information used as part of evidencing 'normal way of working'.

Further intervention programmes will take place following the screening. This is not just for access arrangements purposes.



*For **access arrangement testing** in year 7 to be used throughout KS3 for mid and end of year exams as 'normal way of working'
Re-test during Y10 in preparation for GCSE examinations.*

DASH handwriting speed test

If the student has a standardised score of 84 or below then they are entitled to 25% extra time.

If it appears there is a processing issue or handwriting is illegible, a scribe or laptop can be applied for.

TOWRE reading test

If the student has a standardised score of 84 or below then they are entitled to a (computer) reader **and** 25% extra time.
